Using God's Word Against Your Sinful Flesh

Even after we are converted to faith in Jesus Christ in the gospel and baptism (Titus 3:5-8; Mark 16:16; Romans 6:4), the dangers of our flesh remain: For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption...(Galatians 6:8). Even as those having received the forgiveness of our sins, there remains the danger that our flesh poses to faith in Christ: For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh...(Romans 8:5).

How do we as Christians do battle against our sinful flesh, when we are tempted to sin in word and deed, be it by skipping the divine service on Sundays, dishonoring our father and mother's God-given authority, or seeking sexual pleasure outside the marriage of one man and one woman? Using God's word against our sinful flesh can prevent many a sin of word and deed from even happening. If we are tempted to skip church on Sundays for something else our flesh wants to do: Guard your steps when you go to the house of God. To draw near to listen is better than to offer the sacrifice of fools, for they do not know that they are doing evil (Ecclesiastes 5:1).

If we are tempted to dishonor father and mother, or other authorities appointed by God over us: But if a widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show godliness to their own household and to make some return to their parents, for this is pleasing in the sight of God (1 Timothy 5:4). We have countless places in the Bible to call upon to help us overcome temptations to sin. Any of these can only be done in and through faith in Jesus Christ, our Lord, who died and rose again, to forgive our sins and give us strength, courage, and perseverance in fighting the good fight of faith.

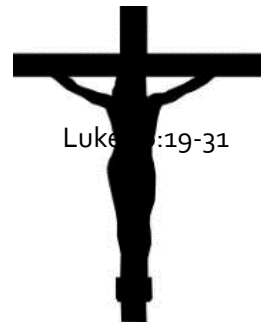

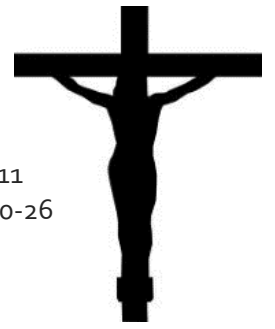

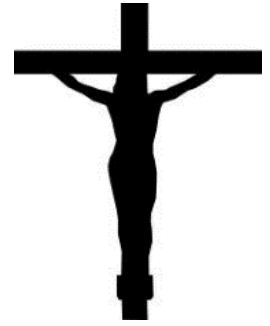
